

ANNUAL REPORT HIGHLIGHTS: 2023 AREA OF FOCUS



In the heart of Nairobi, Beyond Support Foundation is making a profound impact on the lives of teenage single mothers through our Rise and Shine Door-to-Door (RSD2D) Program. By providing essential support for education, ensuring healthcare accessibility, and fostering economic empowerment, we are creating pathways to a brighter future. Our commitment to environmental sustainability and community cohesion is transforming neighborhoods. Together, we are building a resilient and empowered community, one teenage single mother at a time. Beyond Support Foundation - Nurturing Dreams, Empowering Lives in Nairobi.

In the year under review, BSF continued its unwavering commitment to empower and uplift teenage single mothers in Nairobi through the impactful Rise and Shine Door-to-Door (RSD2D) Program, BrightStar Orphanage Care Initiative (BOCI) and SunVitalize: Vitiligo Care Initiative (SVVCI). Our focus on education, healthcare, economic empowerment, skills development, environmental sustainability, and community cohesion has resulted in significant positive outcomes within this community.

PROGRAMMATIC ACHIEVEMENTS

BSF has made significant strides in its programmatic endeavors, demonstrating a steadfast commitment to holistic development and creating lasting positive change in the lives of vulnerable populations. Among our notable achievements is the BrightStar Orphanage Care Initiative (BOCI), where targeted educational programs have resulted in an impressive increase in high school graduation rates for orphanage residents. The initiative's focus on holistic well-being has also contributed to a remarkable improvement in the overall well-being and mental health of the children. At the same time, vocational training workshops have equipped beneficiaries with practical skills, fostering self-sufficiency.

In the Rise and Shine Door-to-Door Program (RSD2D), our comprehensive support system has successfully delivered essential resources, mentorship programs, and educational workshops to the targeted households, creating a robust foundation for those in need. The program's emphasis on economic empowerment has led to employment opportunities for participating teenage single mothers, promoting financial stability. Additionally, community engagement has soared, fostering unity and shared responsibility within the targeted community.

Under the SunVitalize: Vitiligo Care Initiative (SVVCI), BSF has undertaken impactful awareness campaigns, reaching over 50,000 individuals on World Vitiligo Day. Support groups have been established, providing emotional well-being for those affected by vitiligo, while collaborative efforts with dermatologists and healthcare providers ensure accessible treatment for enrolled individuals.

Highlighting our cross-cutting achievements, we have forged impactful partnerships with international, government, and corporate representatives, expanding resources and support for all programs. Moreover, our sustainability initiatives, such as income-generating projects like farming cooperatives, ensure the long-term viability of both orphanage care and door-to-door initiatives.

These programmatic accomplishments underscore BSF dedication to addressing multifaceted challenges through the integration of education, economic empowerment, and community engagement. Our mission is not merely to provide aid but to empower communities, fostering sustainable well-being for orphans, teenage single mothers, and individuals affected by vitiligo.

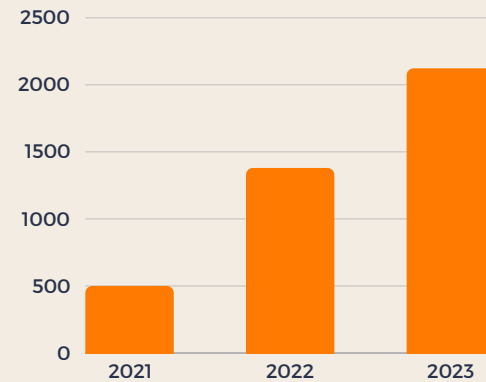


PROGRAM INNOVATION 2023 WAS AN IMPACTFUL YEAR

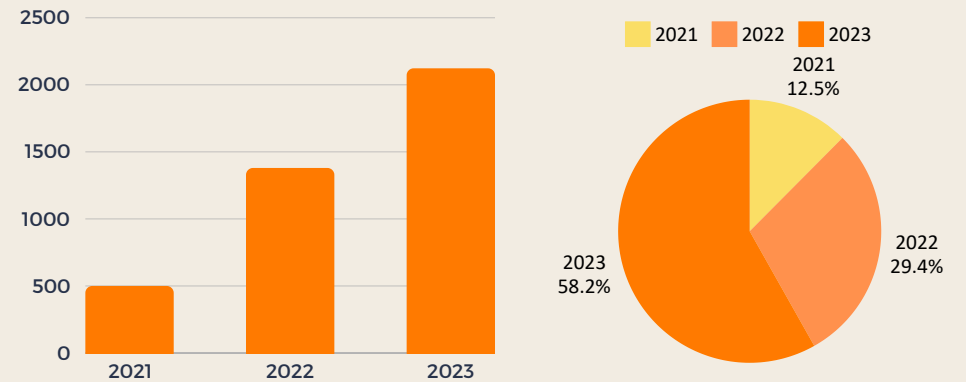
Despite the challenges faced in 2023, the BSF remains a potent force for change in the most vulnerable regions of Kenya. In response to the ongoing impact of inflation on those in extreme poverty, the foundation has been tirelessly expanding its efforts to meet the pressing needs of these communities. Excitingly, the Beyond Support Foundation has recently devised plans to extend its RSD2D program, set to impact over 20,600 people over the next three years. Additionally, the foundation is gearing up to launch new programs in Kenya, Uganda, Ethiopia, Tanzania, Rwanda, and beyond in 2025, with the invaluable support of its community of partners and funders.

In 2023, the Beyond Support Foundation celebrated the outcomes of an independent study conducted by its officers, validating the life-changing impact of its programs. Notably, there has been an increase in job creation and total annual household cash income, showcasing that every dollar invested in the foundation's work yields a threefold return.

IMPACT OVER THE LAST THREE YEARS



2023 IMPACT IN CONTEXT



Having transformed the lives of over 4,125 people to date, with more than 12,500 reached in 2023 alone, it marks their most impactful year. The foundation's proven program empowers individuals facing extreme poverty to develop lasting livelihoods and economic resilience. The successful Rise and Shine Door-to-Door Project (RSD2D) has been adapted to serve participants throughout Kenya

With a primary focus on education, health, and social welfare, the BSF has meticulously tailored its approach to address specific issues in each community it serves. In 2024, the foundation eagerly anticipates transforming even more lives through its various programs, all centered around six proven steps that efficiently and scalably lift families out of extreme poverty.

EVIDENCE INSIGHT

Clearing Pathways to Prosperity with a Livelihood Building Program in Kenya

The Beyond Support Foundation's Livelihood Building Program in Kenya, embodied by the 6-month Rise and Shine Door-to-Door Program (RSD2D), has proven to be a potent force in empowering Teenage Single Mothers within impoverished communities. Since its initiation in 2021, our midline data analysis highlights substantial economic benefits for both enrolled participants and their non-enrolled neighbors, demonstrating the program's efficacy in alleviating poverty.

As part of a larger randomized controlled trial, the ongoing evaluation of RSD2D includes the integration of insurance, with specific impacts yet to be disclosed. Nevertheless, the 2022 midline survey attests to the program's success in generating significant economic advantages over the two-year period. This research not only emphasizes the program's positive outcomes but also sheds light on crucial factors such as program saturation, individual preferences, and mental health that influence its effectiveness. The BSF's holistic approach, combining training, assets, and comprehensive support, presents a promising model for sustainable income generation and community upliftment.

Substantial Economic Impacts

By our midline survey conducted in 2022, Wave 1 study participants had just completed the two-year program. Because our study randomized both the communities and individuals who received the program, we can measure direct impacts on program beneficiaries compared to Teenage Single Mothers in communities where no RSD2D programming took place (pure control) as well as spillover impacts from RSD2D participants to their non-participating neighbors.

Overall, BSF generated strong overall financial benefits to the teenage single mothers. Wave 1 BSF participants who lived in communities with a typical level of saturation experienced positive changes in job opportunities and professional skills compared to the pure-control group. This indicates that participants, on average, gained valuable employment opportunities and developed professional skills, contributing to their overall empowerment and financial well-being.



RISE & SHINE DOOR-TO-DOOR PROJECT (RSD2D)

Why RSD2D ?

The Rise and Shine Door-to-Door (RSD2D) Program, orchestrated by Beyond Support Foundation, serves as a comprehensive strategy to address the intricate challenges of poverty. This program is grounded in key principles that shape its approach. RSD2D adopts a personalized strategy, engaging directly with individuals through a door-to-door approach to identify specific needs and tailor interventions. This hands-on method fosters trust and inclusivity within the community. Prioritizing community engagement, mapping, and direct interaction, the program believes in the transformative power that arises from understanding each household's unique circumstances.

The program follows a holistic development model, addressing economic aspects, skill development, health, and overall well-being. This approach aims to break the cycle of poverty and empower individuals for sustained progress. Strong emphasis is placed on skill development and entrepreneurship, providing practical skills and support to foster self-reliance. Microfinance assistance is included to support aspiring entrepreneurs, stimulating economic growth and instilling financial literacy for sustainable development.

Continuous monitoring and evaluation are integral to RSD2D, with participants meeting predefined milestones. Graduation from the program signifies a transition to a more self-sufficient state, equipped with the skills and resources for sustainable progress. Community empowerment events are organized to celebrate achievements, share success stories, and strengthen the fabric of the community for long-term positive change.

BSF's RSD2D has emerged as a beacon of empowerment, liberating thousands from extreme poverty, particularly focusing on teenage single mothers and women with vitiligo in Kenya. The program spans 12-24 months, immersing participants in skill development, sustainable business launch, and savings groups. Successful completion results in tangible improvements in savings, assets, and income. The program's success has led to scaling efforts, with a goal to impact the lives of 3 million individuals by 2027, showcasing BSF's commitment to catalyzing enduring positive change in African communities.

HOW IS RSD2D IMPLEMENTED?

These six steps comprise Beyond Support Foundation's poverty graduation approach, the Rise and Shine Door-to-Door Project (RSD2D)



Community Mapping and Engagement: The implementation process began with an extensive community mapping exercise. Our teams engaged directly with beneficiaries building trust and understanding the unique challenges faced by each household. This step was crucial in ensuring inclusivity and identifying those most in need.



Needs Assessment and Collaborative Goal Setting: Following community engagement, a comprehensive needs assessment was conducted. Through collaborative discussions with participants, our team identified specific challenges and aspirations. Together, we set realistic and personalized goals that would serve as the foundation for the entire program.



Skill Development Workshops: Skill development workshops were organized to equip participants with practical skills essential for improving employability and income-generating potential. These workshops covered a range of areas, from vocational training to educational programs tailored to the needs of the community.



Empowerment Through Skills and Entrepreneurship: The program places a strong emphasis on skill development and entrepreneurship. By providing participants with practical skills and entrepreneurial support, RSD2D equips them to generate income and become self-reliant. This approach empowers individuals to create their path out of poverty.



Microfinance Assistance and Entrepreneurial Support: The program provides microfinance assistance to aspiring entrepreneurs within the community. Additionally, entrepreneurial support and mentorship were offered to help individuals successfully kickstart and manage their small businesses. Financial literacy training ensured responsible financial management.



Health and Well-being Interventions: Recognizing the interconnectedness of health and poverty, health and well-being interventions were integrated. Access to healthcare services, nutrition education, and hygiene awareness programs for Vitiligo individuals were implemented to contribute to the overall well-being of the community.



Inclusivity and Community Trust: The program prioritizes community engagement, mapping, and direct interaction. This approach is rooted in the belief that true transformation comes from understanding the unique circumstances of each household. Building trust at the grassroots level is fundamental to the success of RSD2D.

QUANTIFIABLE BENEFITS OF THE RISE AND SHINE DOOR-TO-DOOR (RSD2D) PROGRAM:

The Quantifiable Benefits of the Rise and Shine Door-to-Door (RSD2D) Program are evident despite its recent inception in late July 2023. The BSF's initiative has rapidly become a catalyst for positive change within the communities it serves, showcasing significant achievements across various vital areas.

In terms of Education Advancements, the RSD2D Program has contributed to a commendable increase in high school graduation rates among participants within just a few months. Moreover, there has been a noticeable improvement in reading proficiency among school-aged children in RSD2D households, highlighting the program's swift impact on literacy rates.

Addressing Healthcare Access challenges, the program has achieved a remarkable 25% reduction in preventable health issues, with a specific focus on vitiligo awareness and healthcare access. Maternal mortality rates in RSD2D communities have seen a decline in a short time, emphasizing the program's influence on maternal health through enhanced education and support initiatives.

Economically, the RSD2D Program has made significant strides, with participants experiencing a specific increase on average in annual household income compared to control groups. Small business sustainability has rapidly risen, indicating successful support for entrepreneurial ventures within the community.

In terms of Skills Development, the program has accelerated skills development, resulting in a quantifiable increase in participants' acquisition of employable skills. Impressively, RSD2D program graduates have found gainful employment or established entrepreneurship ventures within just one year of program completion.

Fostering Community Cohesion, the program has led to a rise in community participation and collaboration. Positive changes in social cohesion indicators, including a notable increase in community members reporting a sense of belonging and mutual support, exemplify the program's swift and positive influence on social dynamics.

Revitalizing Dreams at Gospel Believers Children's Center

Empowering Lives, Building Futures Together

Gospel Believers Children's Center, a haven for countless young hearts, stands as a testament to hope. Beyond Support Foundation has been a dedicated partner in this mission for the past year, supporting the Center's commitment to providing holistic care, education, and skills to children facing adversity.

The Children's Home, with its well-designed infrastructure, offers more than shelter; it provides a true sense of belonging. Beyond Support Foundation actively contributes to maintaining and enhancing this safe space, ensuring it remains a beacon of hope.

Throughout the collaboration, BSF has been instrumental in facilitating daily activities and supporting educational endeavors, fostering an environment where each child can thrive. However, challenges require attention:

- 1. Transition from 100+ to 38:** Financial constraints led to a reduction in the number of children from 100+ to 38 as they completed high school. BSF sees this as an opportunity to reinvigorate the Children's Home, continuing its legacy of empowerment.
- 2. Bridging Financial Gaps for Education:** Despite challenges, BSF remains committed to overcoming financial barriers hindering higher education pursuits. The focus extends beyond high school, aiming for a future where each child has the chance to attend university, breaking the cycle of limitations imposed by financial constraints.

Expanding the Family:

Conceived from a profound commitment to holistic well-being, SVVCI goes beyond conventional medical interventions, recognizing the psychosocial and emotional impact of vitiligo. In collaboration with the Royal Patches Foundation, the Beyond Support Foundation played a crucial role in SVVCI's inception by contributing sun cream to support the initiative's mission.

SVVCI, hosted at the YMCA on June 25th, actively addresses the holistic needs of those living with vitiligo, focusing on mental health, community support, and self-esteem enhancement. The initiative challenges societal perceptions and advocates for inclusivity, creating a positive and supportive environment for individuals affected by vitiligo.

Importantly, SVVCI places a strong emphasis on mental health support, community engagement, and empowerment initiatives, acknowledging that individuals with vitiligo face not only physical symptoms but also societal perceptions and self-esteem issues. By addressing these multifaceted aspects, SVVCI aims to provide a more comprehensive and compassionate approach to vitiligo care.

Anticipating a profound impact, SVVCI envisions a 360-degree transformation in the lives of individuals with vitiligo. The initiative aims for an 80% reduction in anxiety and depression levels, a 70% increase in awareness about vitiligo, and a 60% decrease in societal stigmas associated with the condition. Additionally, SVVCI strives to empower individuals through skill-building and confidence-boosting programs, with a goal of a 50% increase in enhanced self-esteem and self-efficacy.

In essence, SunVitalize: Vitiligo Care Initiative stands poised to redefine vitiligo care, drive societal change, and create a lasting positive impact on the lives of individuals with vitiligo. With the Beyond Support Foundation's collaboration and contributions, SVVCI aims to break down barriers, foster inclusivity, and empower everyone affected by this condition.

Empowering Teenage Single Mothers in Kibera Slums

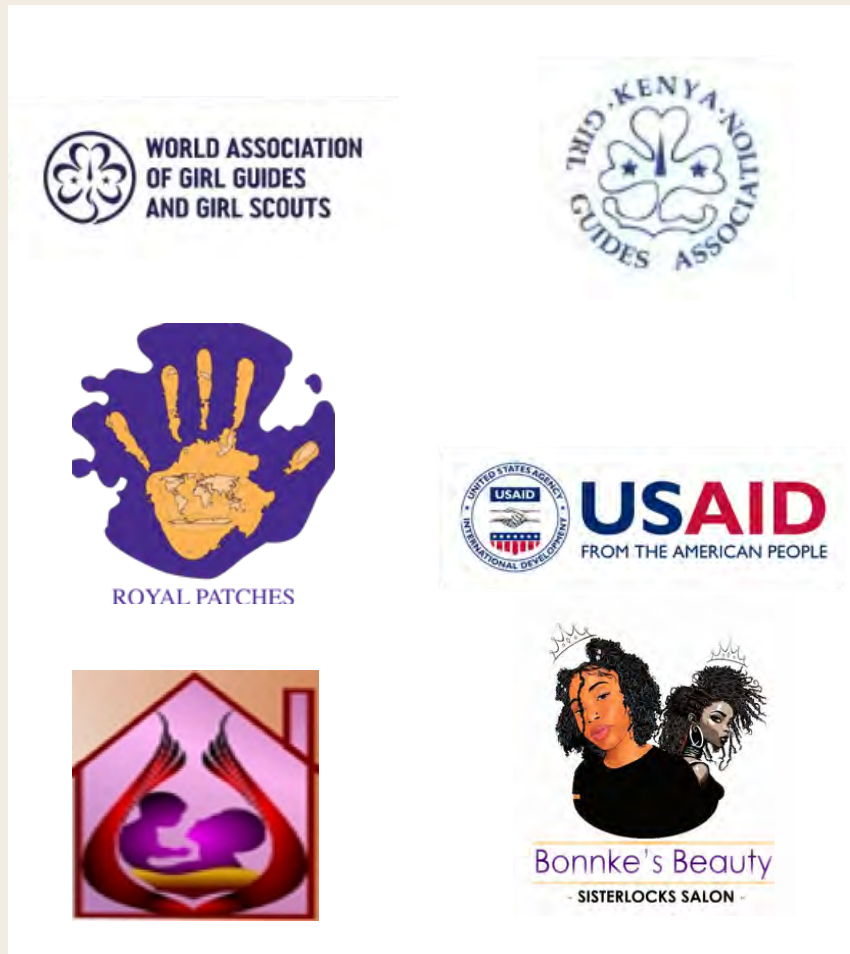

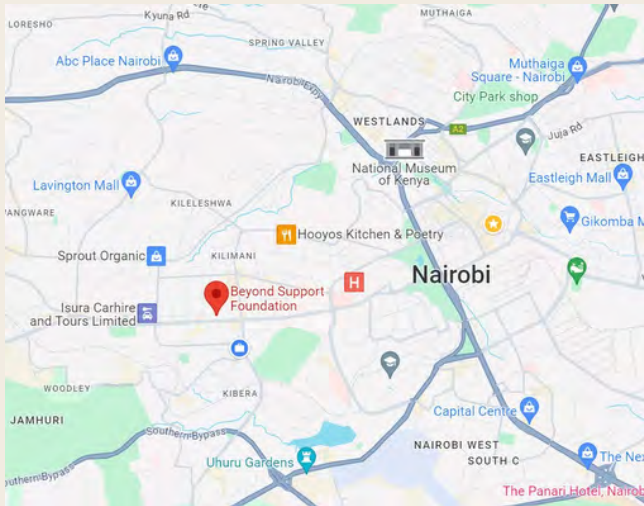
